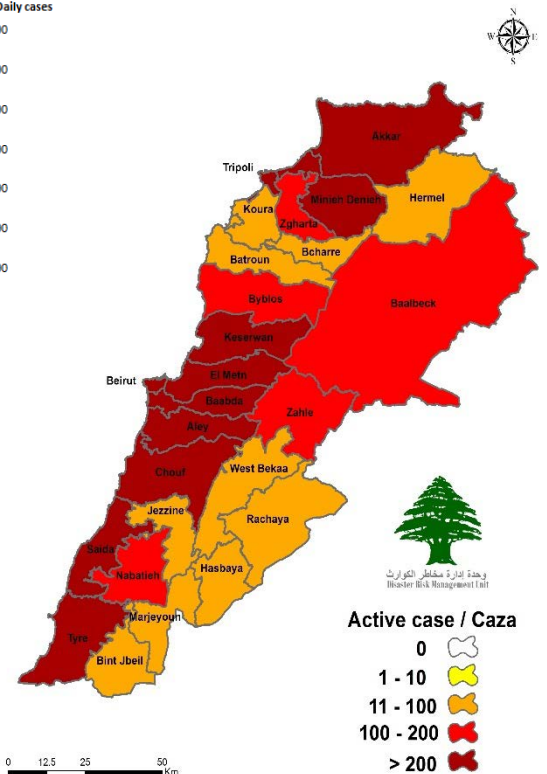

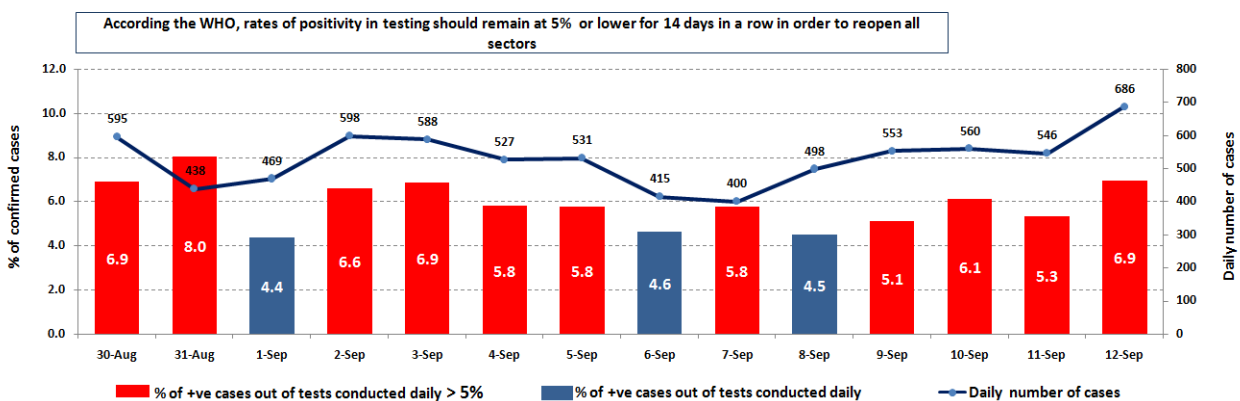

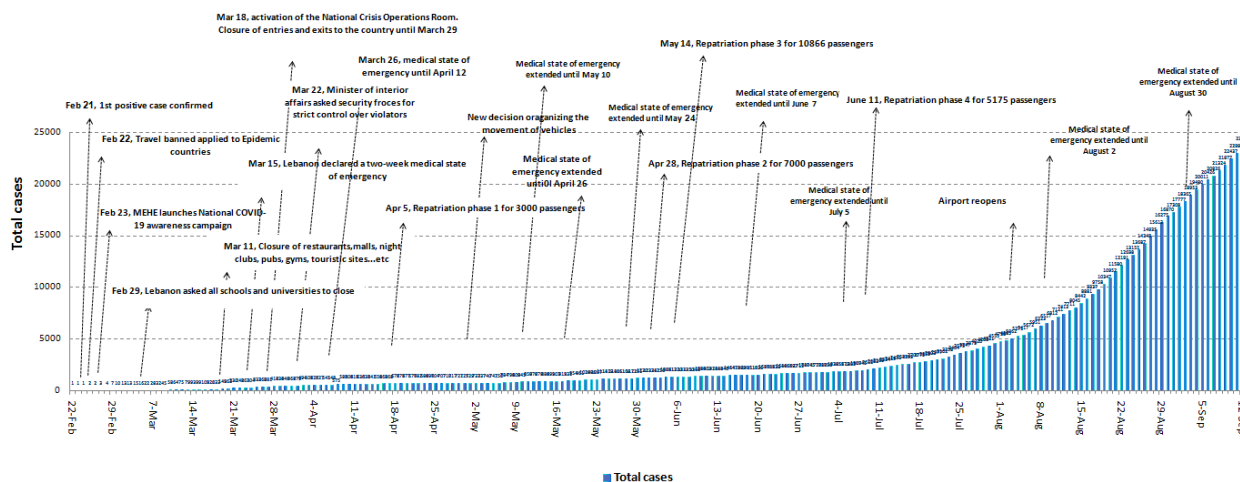

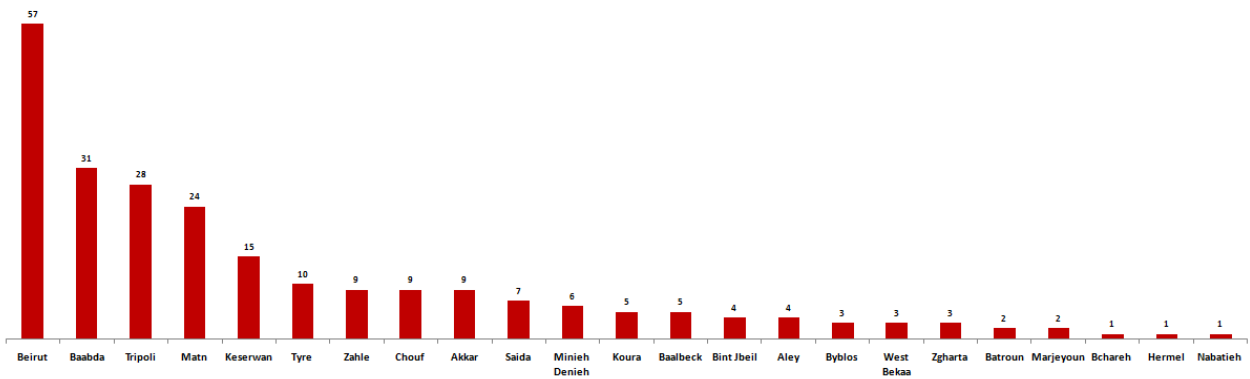
The percentage of positive cases out of the number of daily checks (30 August to 12 September 2020)



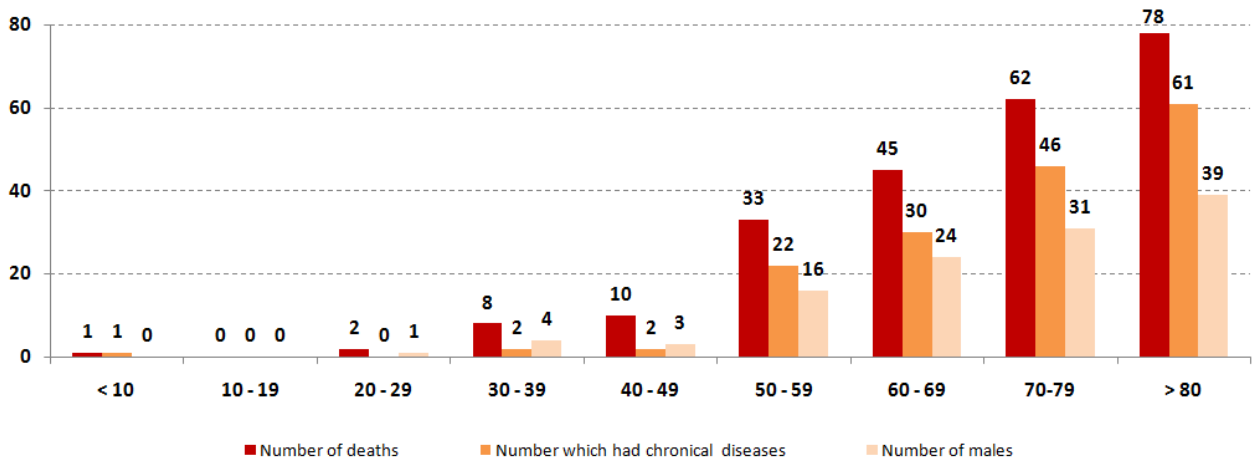
Chronology of decisions according to number of cases



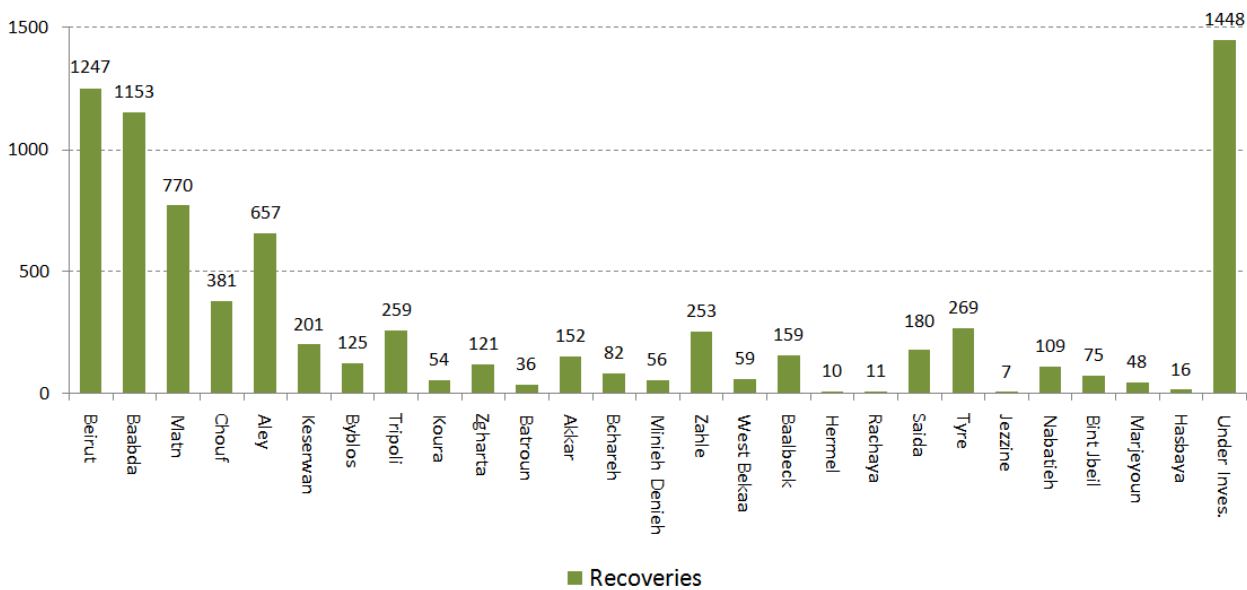
Distribution of deaths by Governorates



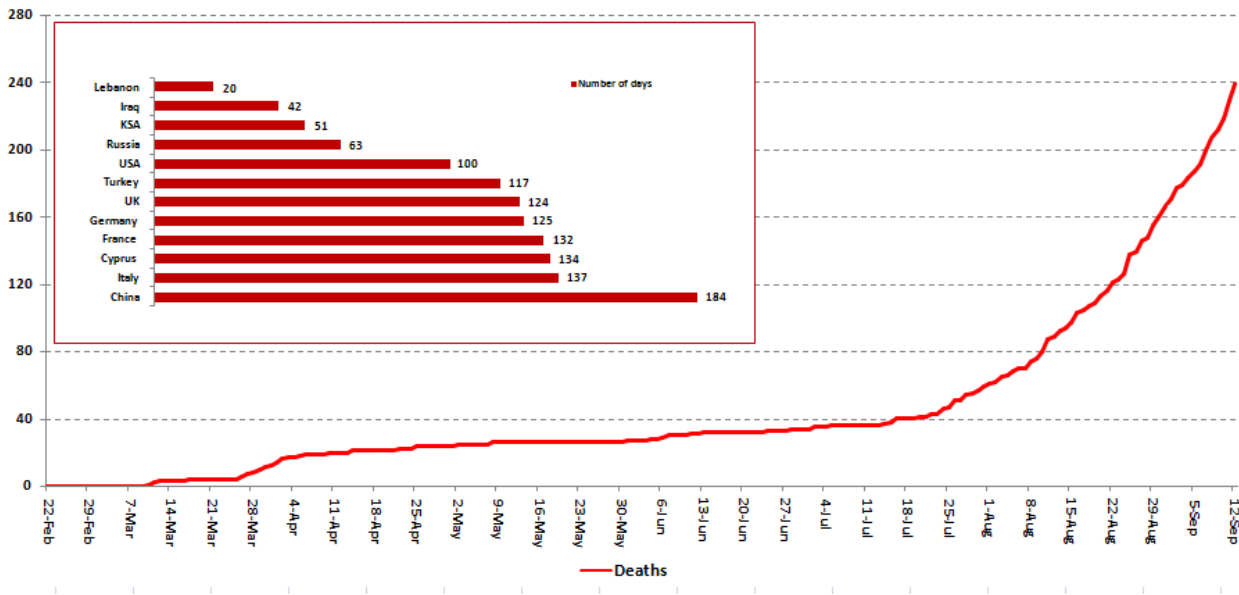
Distribution of deaths by Age

Comparison of the rate of doubling of the number of deaths in Lebanon with other countries (death doubling rate)

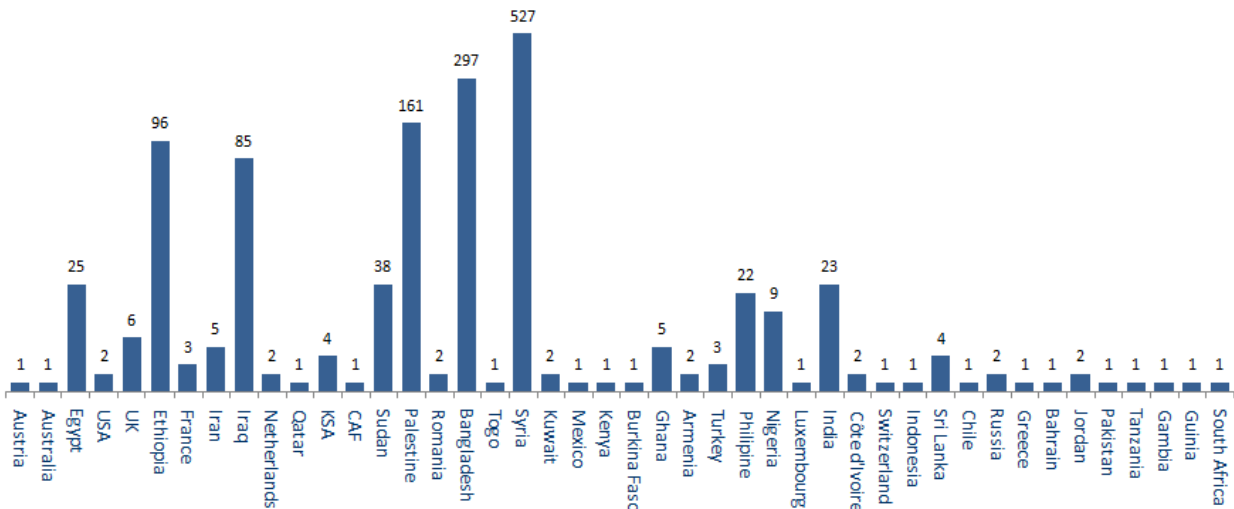


The distribution of the recorded deaths during the past 24 hours

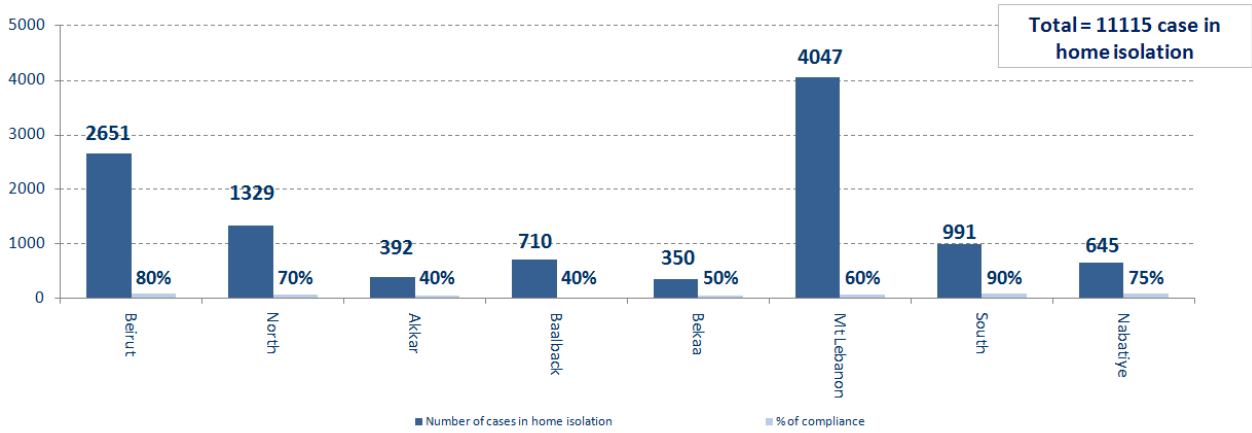

Distribution of cases by nationality

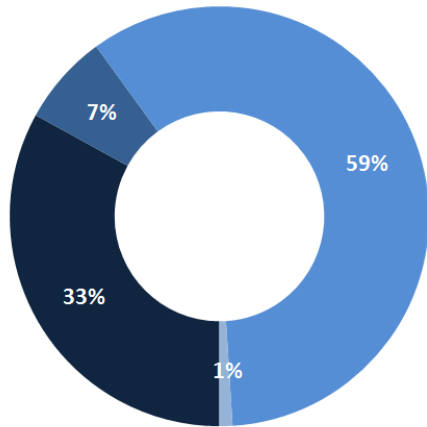

Number of individuals in home isolation and percentage of commitment to isolation

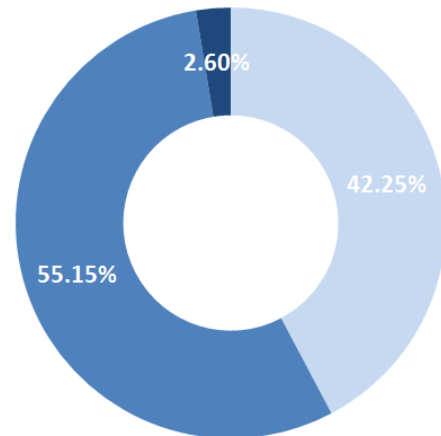

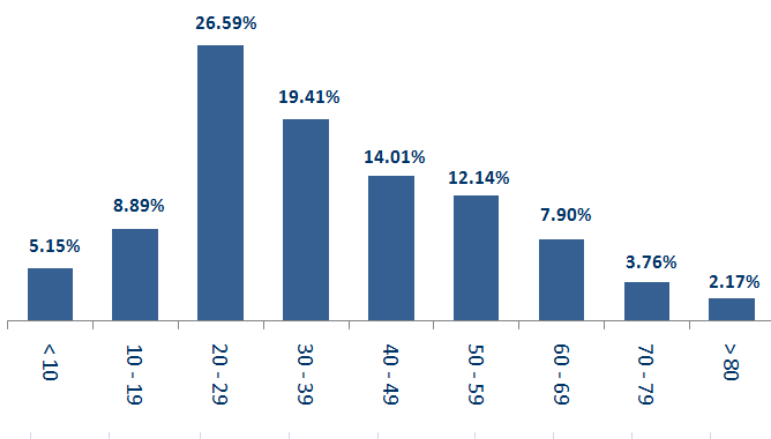

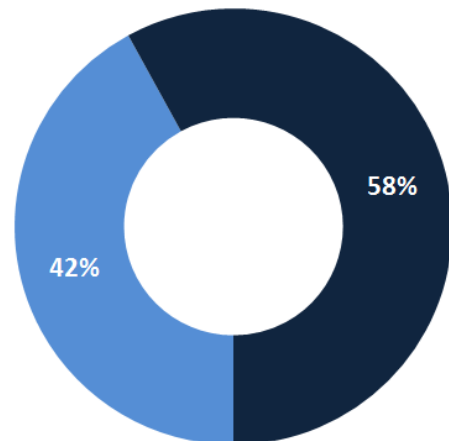

Distribution by age

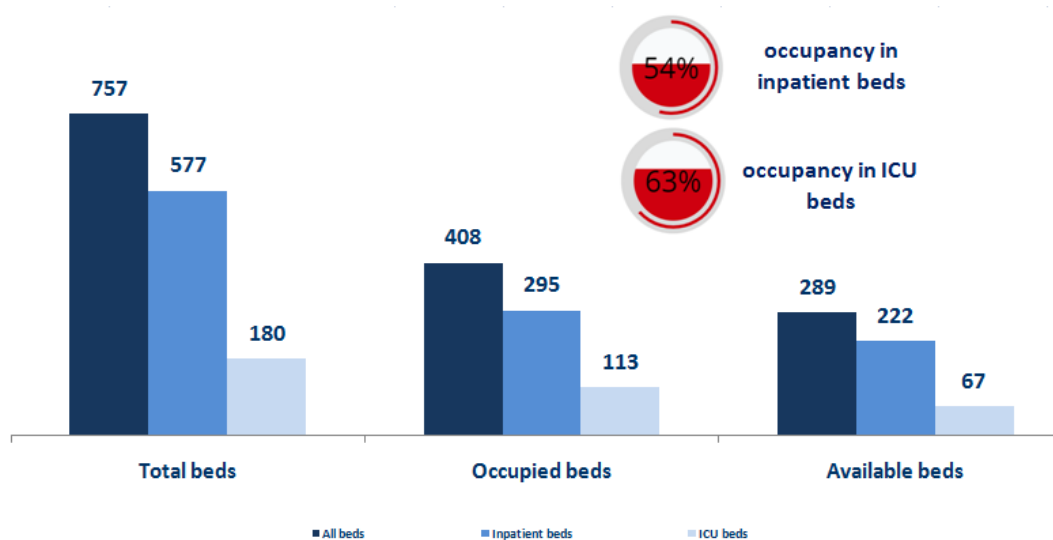


Distribution according to gender

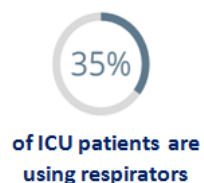
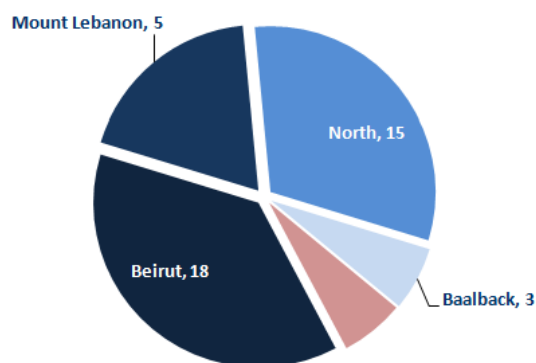
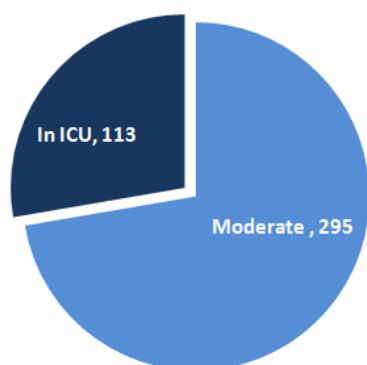
The number of beds available for those infected with Coronavirus and the occupancy rate



Distribution of hospitalizations

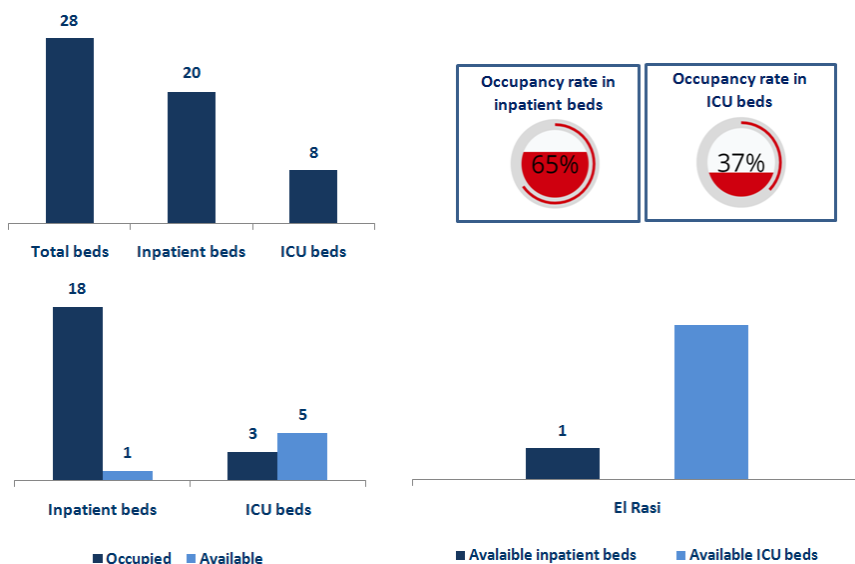
Distributed cases that use respirators

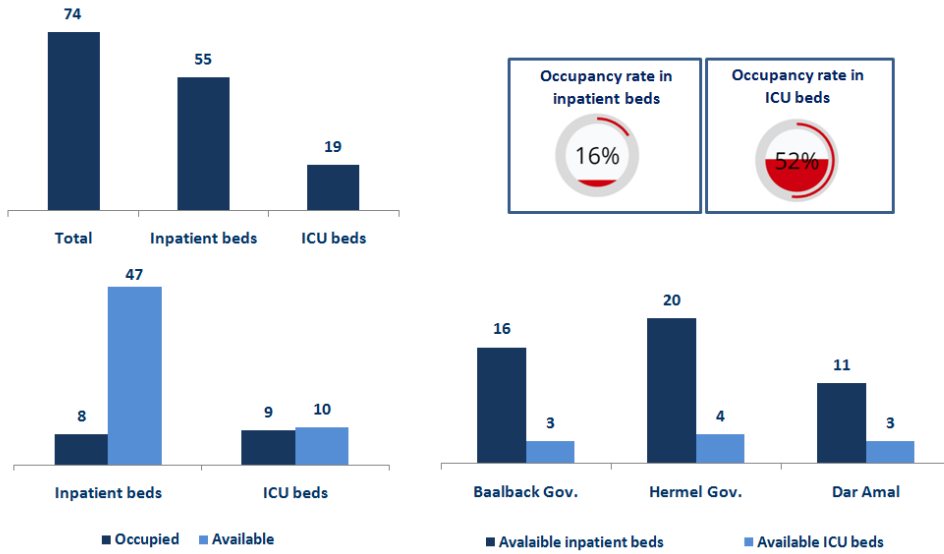


The distribution of the beds available for those infected with Coronavirus in the governorates and the occupancy rate

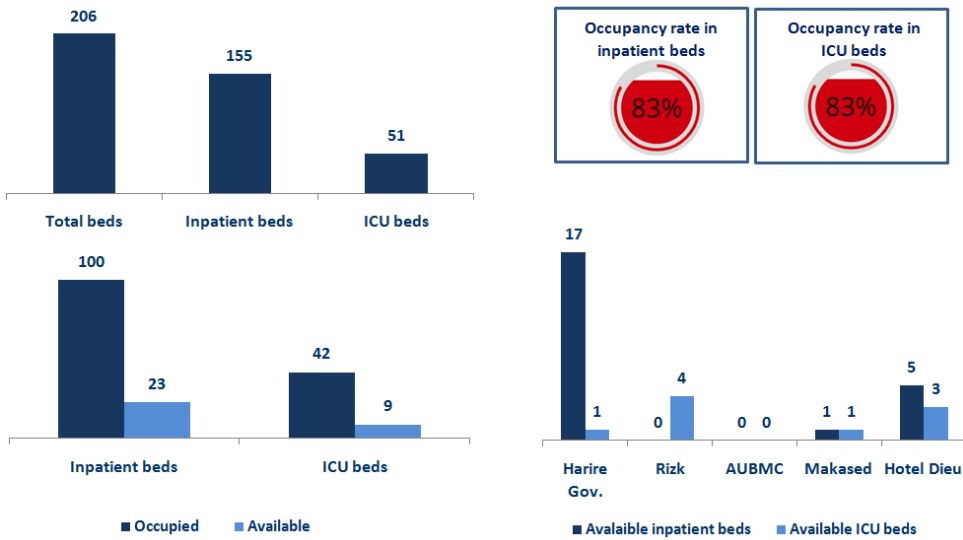

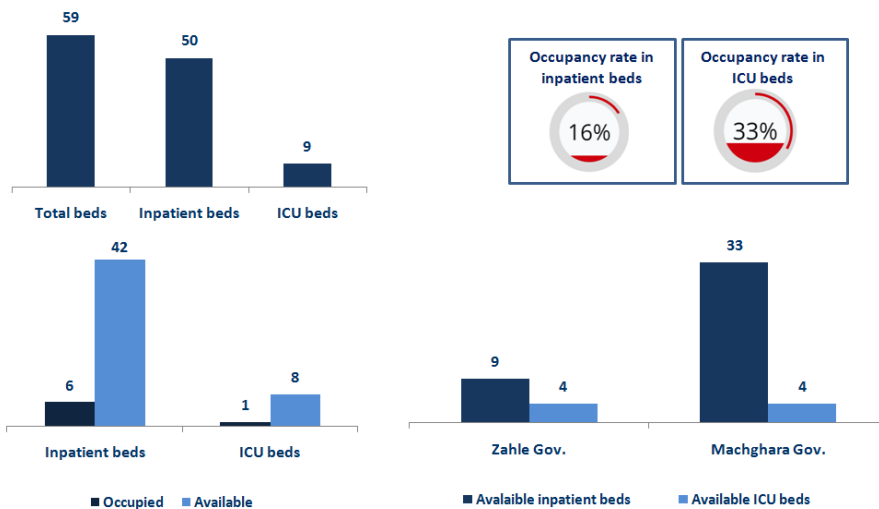

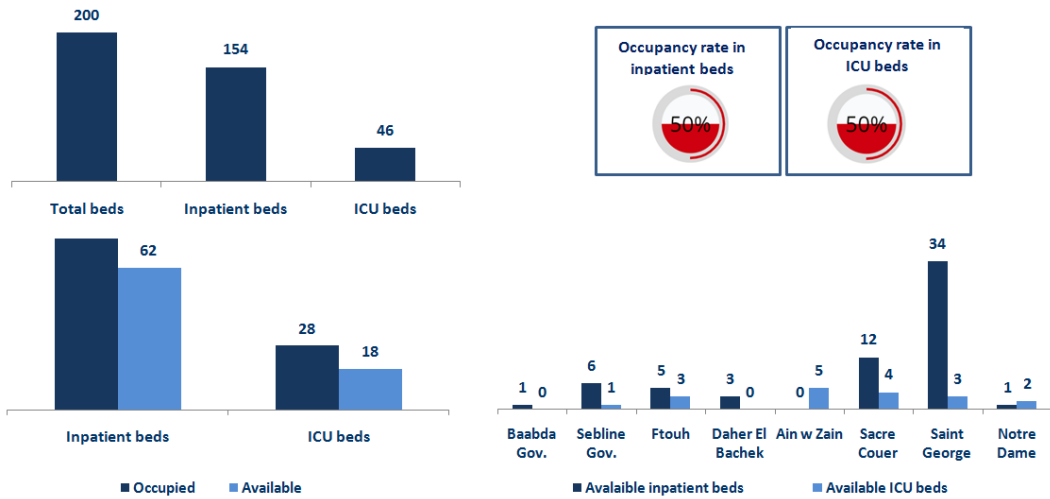

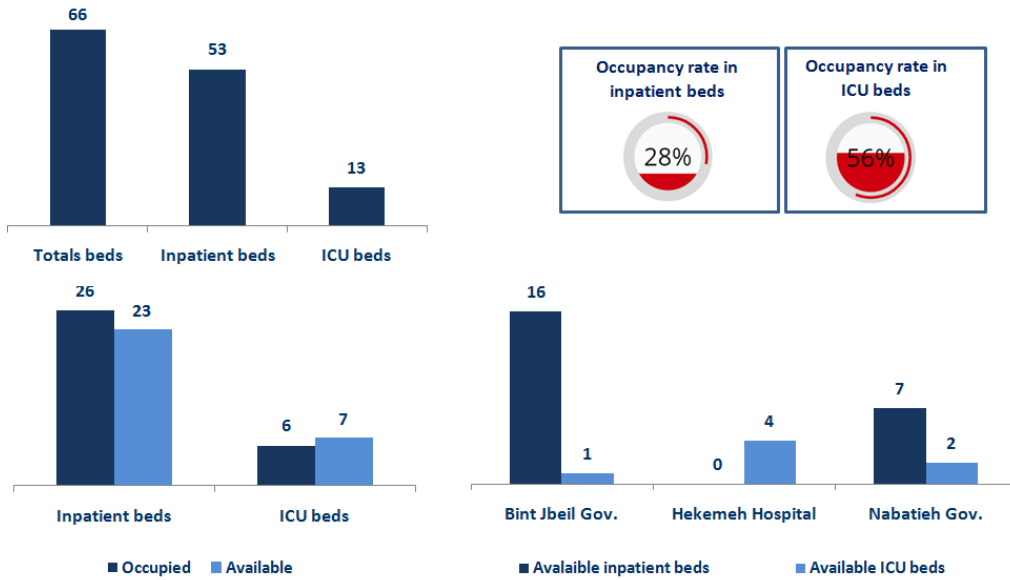

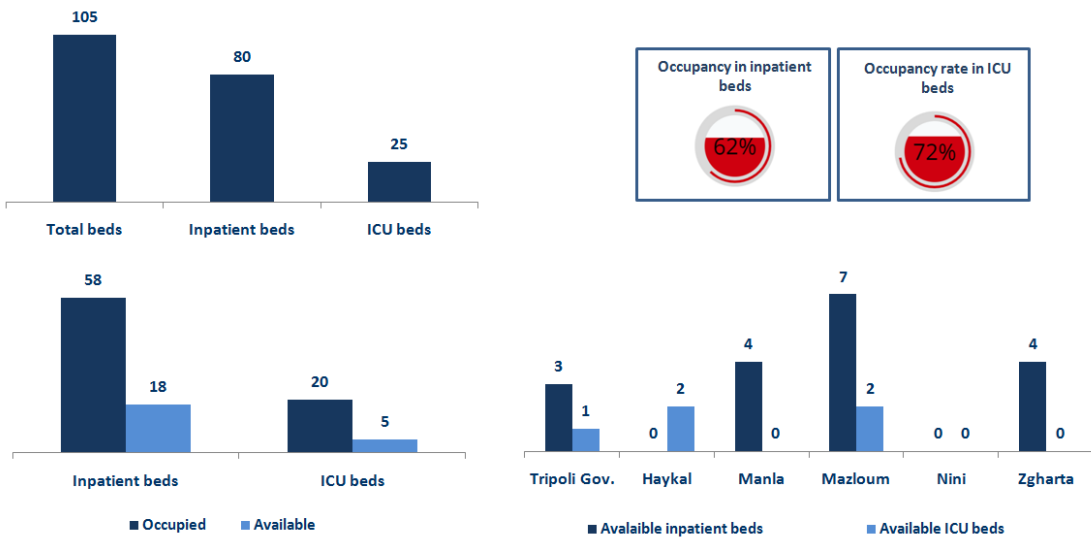

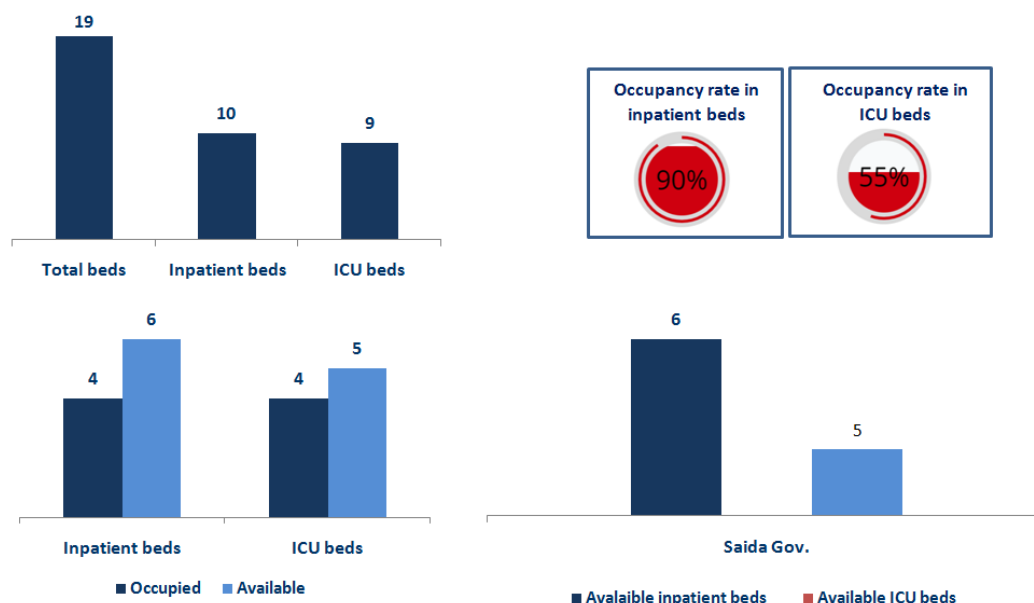

Ministry of Public Health

- The Ministry of Public Health opened the Corona department at Qana Governmental Hospital in Tire District, as part of ensuring readiness to receive Corona cases in the region.

- The Ministry of Public Health, through the Department of Epidemiological Surveillance and the Hotline, continues to track infections with the Coronavirus and their contacts, and to organize testing campaigns directed at various regions and to prepare the daily report of infections and their spread and distribution.

The ministry issued the results of additional examinations for the upcoming trips on September 10, 2020, where ten positive cases were recorded, which were distributed over the following flights:

General announcements

The implementation of the Ministry of Interior and Municipalities Decision No. 1056 of 9/8/2020 related to amending the opening and closing times of industrial and commercial establishments, as the timing of exit and entry into the streets was changed from the first hour after midnight until six in the morning, and the decision allowed bars and cabarets to open Nightclubs, electronic game stores, public parks, theaters, and cinemas, with strict enforcement of the preventive measures and measures adopted, provided that the swimming pools, indoor sports stadiums, amusement parks, and indoor spaces designated for children's games remain closed.

Examples of lack of adherence to safety measures

- Demand gatherings and demonstrations.
- Failure to comply with the preventive measures and procedures required in a number of stores and markets (putting on a muzzle or face mask, sterilizing hands, maintaining a safe distance).
- Non-compliance with the 50% occupancy rate in several restaurants and amusement game centers.
- Gatherings for social events.
- Failure of those in contact with confirmed cases to adhere to home isolation procedures until the results of the laboratory tests are issued.
