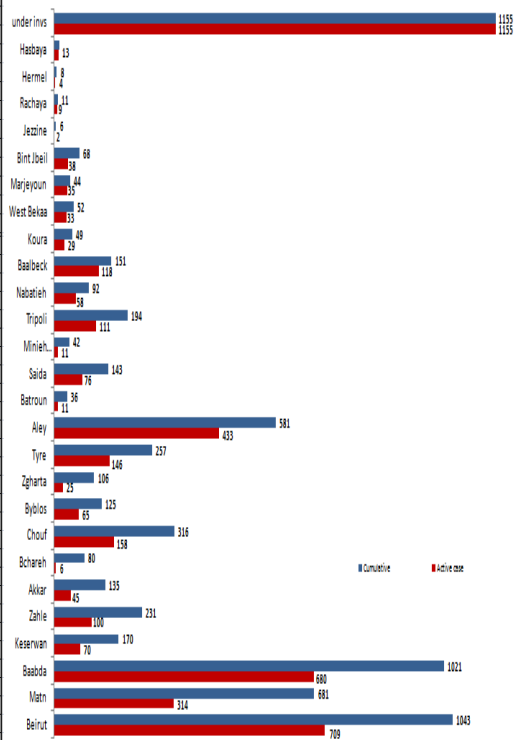

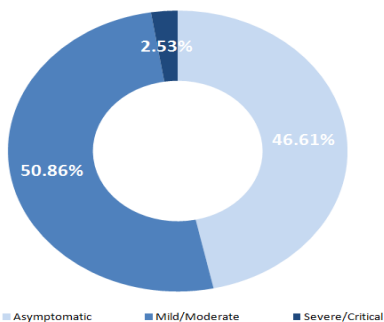

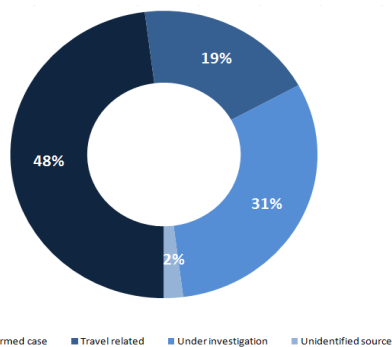

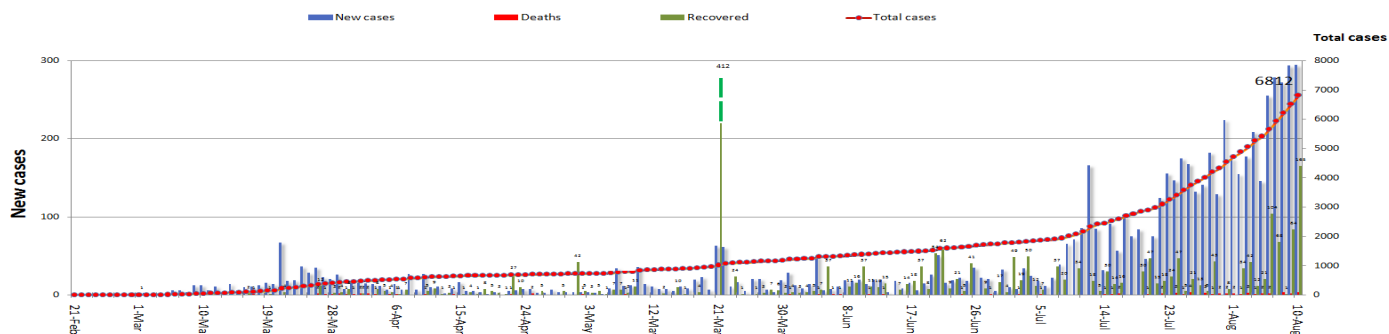

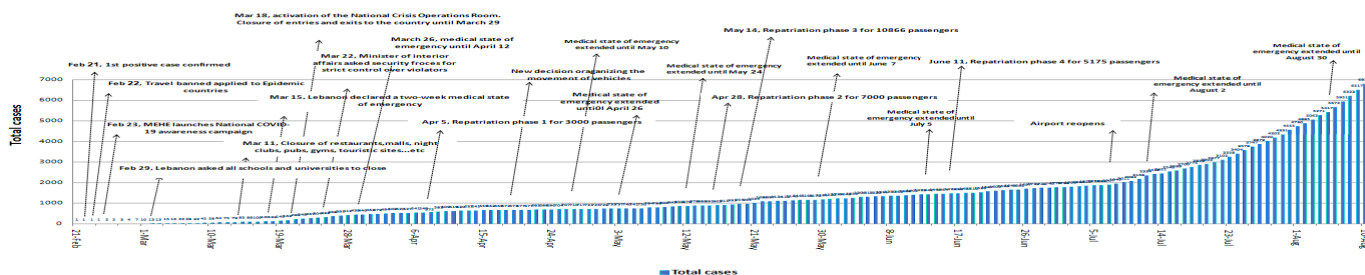

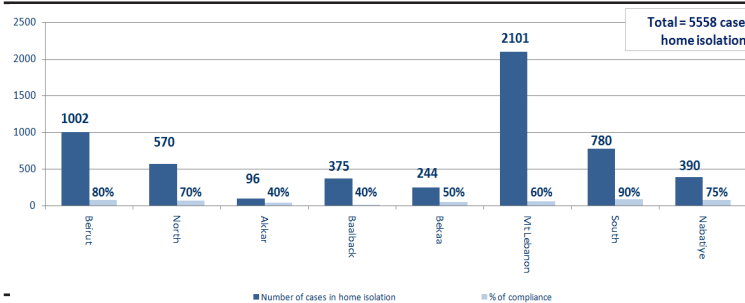
## Cases per day



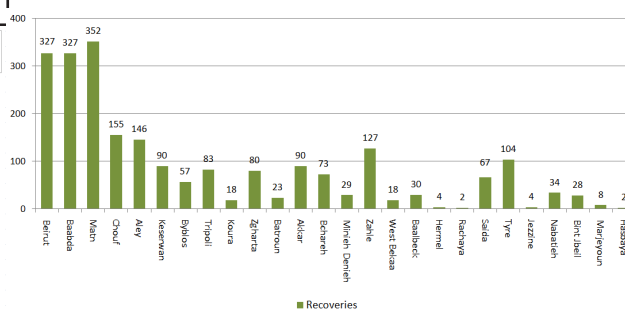
## Chronology of decisions according to number of cases



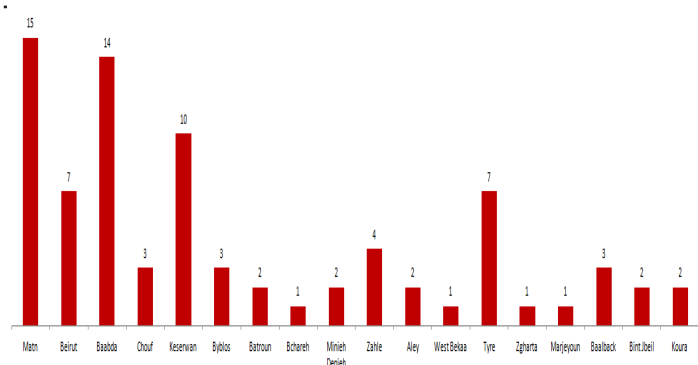
## Number of individuals in home isolation and percent of commitment to isolation



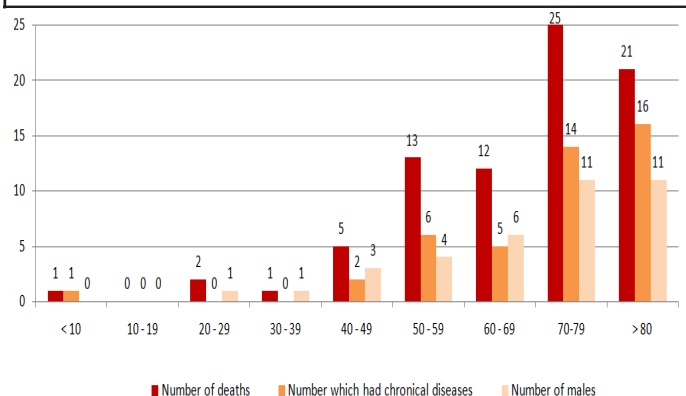
## Distribution of recoveries by area



## Distribution of deaths by governorates

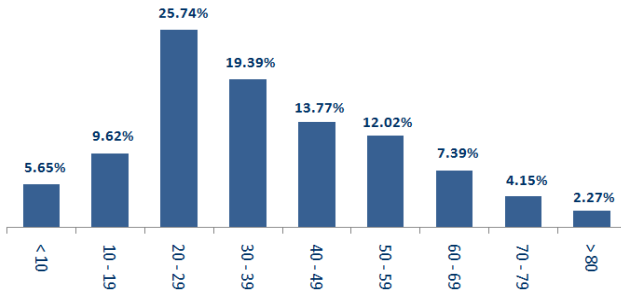


## Distribution of deaths by age



## Distribution of cases by age group

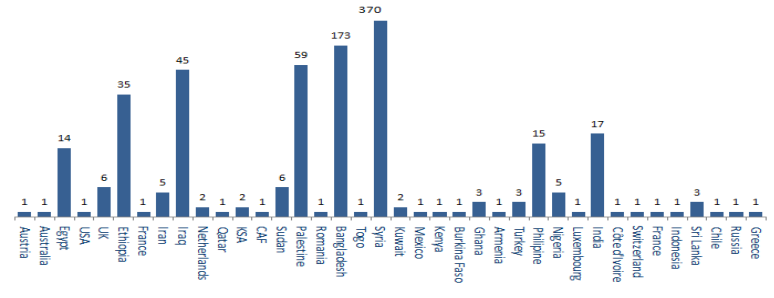
Distribution of cases by age group (%)



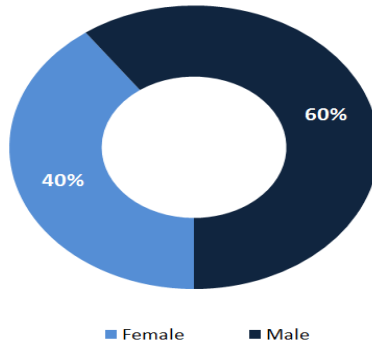
## Distribution of cases by nationality

## Decisions and actions taken

### Ministry of Public Health

- the ministry is increasing the number of conducted PCR tests in different Lebanese regions to examine the level of the virus' spread in the country.
- issued the results of PCR tests conducted for those arriving to Lebanon on Aug. 7 and Aug. 8 and only 1 new case was recorded.
- following up on providing the needed equipment for public hospitals

### Security services (Internal Security Forces, General Security, State Security, Army, General Directorate of Civil Defense)

- The army carried out patrols in different Lebanese regions, distributed food boxes to families in need (CIMIC) and dispersed gatherings.
- General Security Forces followed up on the airport's set regulations for the return of Lebanese expatriates to their homeland and tracked potential cases in various Lebanese regions and ensured that they're adhering to the terms of home isolation. forces also announce the municipalities being isolated.
- State security forces followed up on positive and suspected cases in home isolation. forces also announced the results on tests conducted on suspected cases. forces also announced the measures being taken in municipalities for preventing the spread of the virus. forces also reported the commitment rates to the general mobilization decision in the governorates: Beirut (90%), Mount Lebanon (80%), Baalbek Hermel (90%), Bekaa (70%), North (75%), Akkar ( 55%), Nabatieh (95%), South (80%).
- Supporting monitors from the Ministry of Tourism in

carrying out field trips to establishments and restaurants in Nabatiyeh Governorate, and drafting minutes for violators.

- The General Directorate of Civil Defense prepared 427 personnel and 69 ambulances, to interfere, when necessary, and transport those infected with the emerging coronavirus.
- ISF aided the municipalities of Qalamoun (Tripoli), and Helaniyeh (Baalbek) in isolating the villages.
