



Distribution of deaths by governorates





Decisions and actions taken

Ministry of Public Health

- The Ministry announced that all hospitals are obligated to treat all patient, including those suspected of having covid19
- The Ministry issued a circular on the mechanism that should improve the detection of positive cases across land and sea borders. The ministry will cooperate with laboratories to put medical teams that will exmaine all those arriving to lebanon arrivals across borders and for children under the age of 12 : tests will cost: 100,000 Lebanese pounds from the Lebanese nationals, 150,000 pounds from the Syrian and Arab nationalities and 50 US dollars from other nationalities, provided that the results of the tests are produced within 48 hours. Following up on all positive cases and arrivals to lebanon daily-in both hospitals and home isolation.
- the ministry is increasing the number of conducted PCR tests in different Lebanese regions to examine the level of the virus' spread in the country.

Security services (Internal Security Forces, General Security, State Security, Army, General Directorate of Civil Defense)

- The army carryed out patrols in different Lebanese regions, distributed food boxes to families in need (CIMIC) and dispersed gatherings.
- General Security Forces followed up on the airport's set regulations for the return of Lebanese expatriates to their homeland and tracked potential cases in various Lebanese regions and ensured that they're adhering to the terms of home isolation. forces also announce the municipalities being isolated.
- State security forces followed up on positive and suspected cases in home isolation. forces also announced the results on

tests conducted on suspected cases. forces also announced the measures being taken in muncipalities for preventing the spread of the virus. forces also reported the commitment rates to the general mobilization decision in the governorates: Beirut (90%), Mount Lebanon (80%), Baalbek Hermel (90%), Bekaa (70%), North (75%), Akkar (55%), Nabatieh (95%), South (80%).

- Supporting monitors from the Ministry of Tourism in carrying out field trips to establishments and restaurants in Nabatiyeh Governorate, and drafting minutes for violators.
- The General Directorate of Civil Defense prepared 427 personnel and 69 ambulances, to interfere, when necessary, and transport those infected with the emerging coronavirus.
- ISF aided the muncipalities of Qalamoun (Tripoli), and Helaniyeh (Baalbek) in isolating the villages. ISF also number of fine

Ministry of Foreign Affairs

- The Ministry communicates on a daily basis with foreign embassies that wish to evacuate their citizens in coordination with the National COVID Committee
- The Ministry is following up on the entry and exit of diplo-

mats visiting Lebanon on official missions, in coordination with the relevant embassies.

- The Ministry is coordinating with the Syrian embassy in Lebanon and with the General Directorate of General Security the movement of entry and exit through the border crossings to ensure the implementation of the procedures followed based on the decisions of the Council of Ministers.
- The Ministry is coordinating on a daily basis with the Lebanese missions on the development of the situation in their host countries and the situation of expatriates

General Decisions

- extended the general mobilization decision accroding to ciruclar 6665/2020 from 3/8/2020 to 30/8/2020
- following up on the Ministry of Tourism's issued statement stating that bakeries, restaurant, and can open Al Adha holiday from from 6:00 AM until 8:00 PM. take aways and deliveries are only allowed.
- the Ministry of Interior and Municipalities issued resolution No. 946 on 4/8/2020regarding the closure of some sectors as part of the public mobilizaiton decision: all public and private institutions from Thursday morning on 6/8/2020 until the morning of Tuesday 11/8/2020 that the closure will include commercial markets (stores, Malls, outlets), popular markets, commercial companies, banks, financial institutions and all public and tourist facilities. a crufew was also set between six in the evening and six in the morning for the

duration of the general closure.

Examples of lack of adherence to safety measures

- Demonstration, and Roadblocks
- Overcrowding in restaurants and cafes and failure to comply with the permitted number of customers (50%)
- Gathering of citizens in hiking areas without committing to preventive measures
- Non-compliance of citizens with preventive measures
- Gathering in cafes
- hookah
- gatherings on beaches and sidewalks without wearing masks.
- social gatherings and celebrations and kids areas
