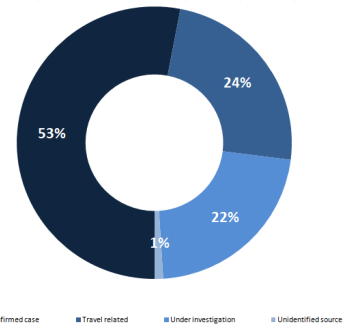

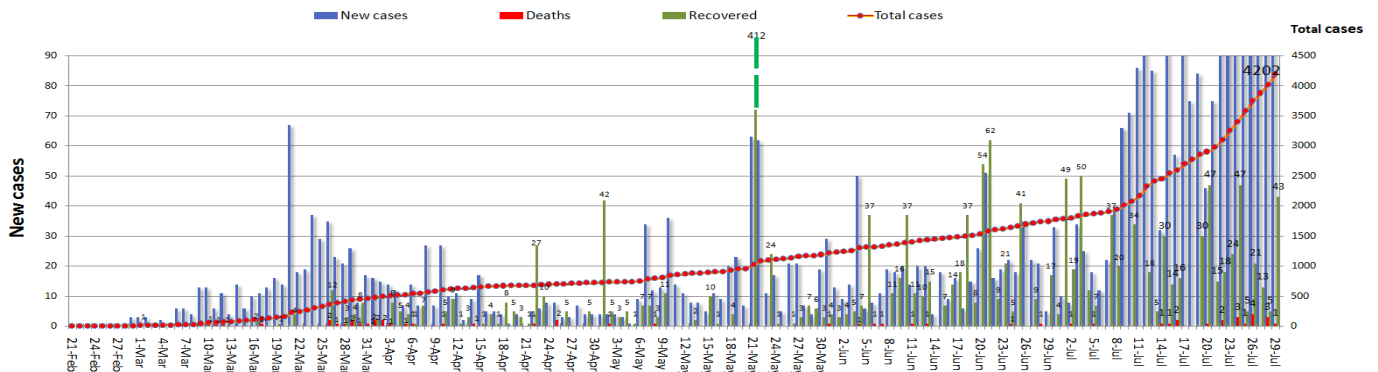
## Status of cases



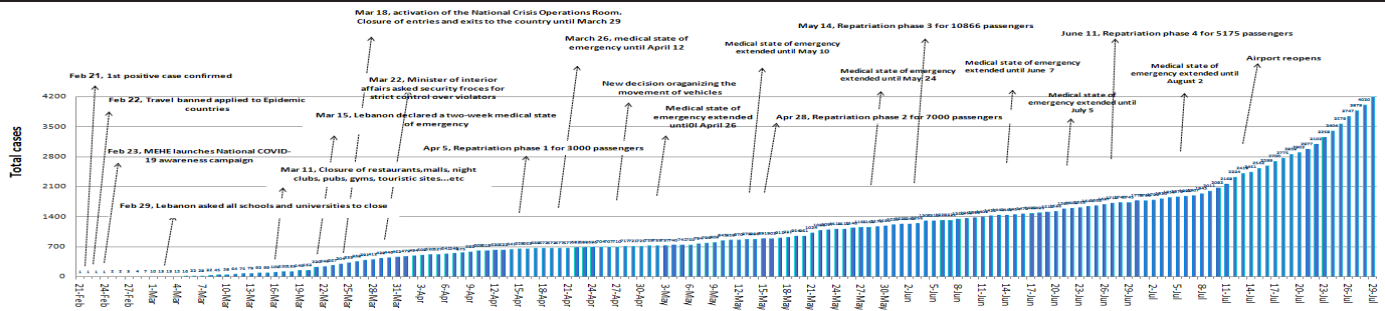

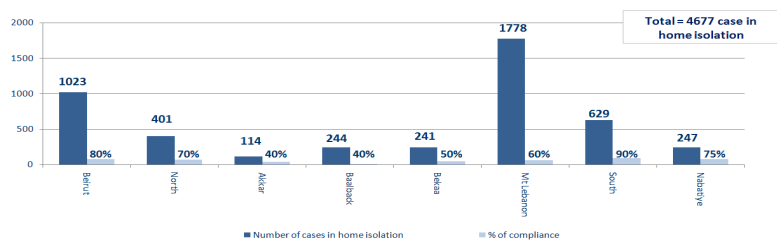
## Cases per day



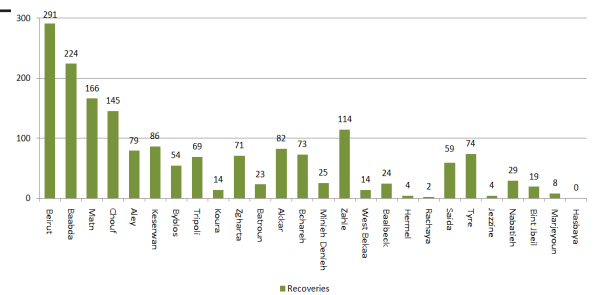
## Chronology of decisions according to number of cases



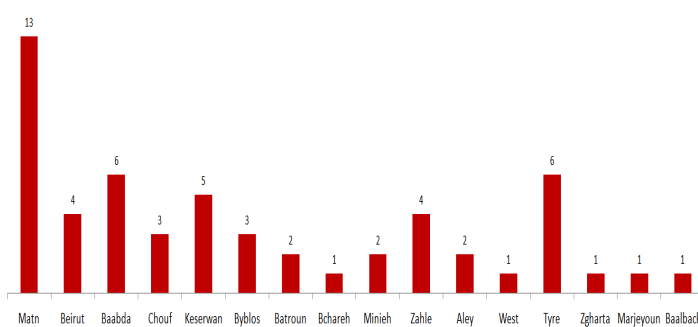
## age of commitment to isolation



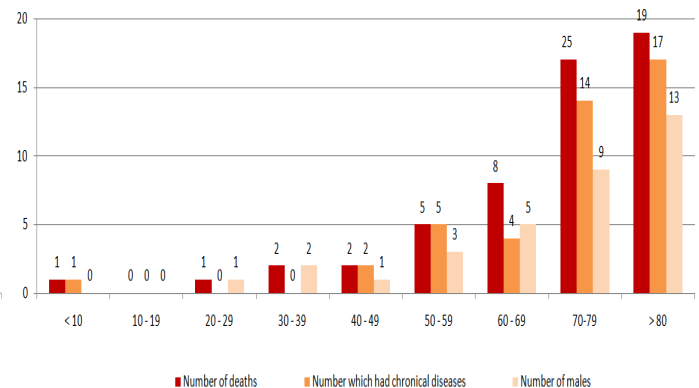
## Distribution of recoveries by area



## Distribution of deaths by governorates

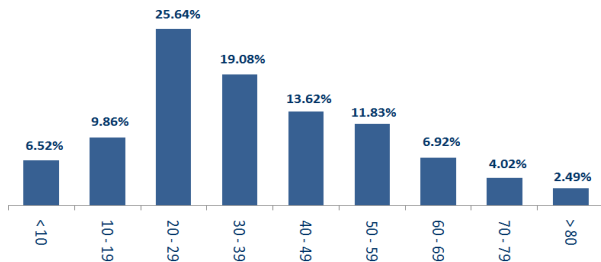


## Distribution of deaths by age



## Distribution of cases by age group

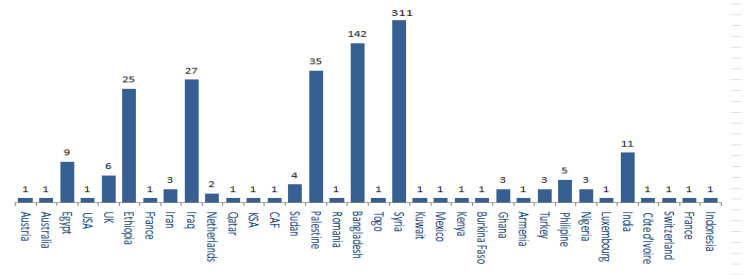
Distribution of cases by age group (%)



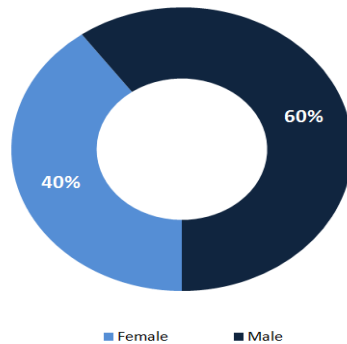
## Distribution of cases by nationality

## Decisions and actions taken

### Ministry of Public Health

- The Ministry opened the Corona Department at Dr. Abdullah Al-Rassi Hospital in Halba, Akkar, with the support of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees in Lebanon.
- The Ministry of Public Health announced that Lebanon has become in the 4th stage which means the virus is at the level of a local outbreak. This requires a full commitment to safety procedures. Additionally, all cases that do not have the general safety conditions for isolation at home will be transferred to the approved quarantine centers.
- The ministry issued the results of PCR tests conducted for arrivals to Lebanon on July 26 and 27:

- The ministry is following up on all positive cases and arrivals to Lebanon daily in both hospitals and home isolation.

### Security services (Internal Security Forces, General Security, State Security, Army, General Directorate of Civil Defense)

- The army carried out patrols in different Lebanese regions, distributed food boxes to families in need (CIMIC) and dispersed gatherings.

- General Security Forces followed up on the airport's set regulations for the return of Lebanese expatriates to their homeland and tracked potential cases in various Lebanese regions and ensured that they're adhering to the terms of home isolation. Forces also announced the municipalities being isolated.
- State security forces followed up on positive and suspected cases in home isolation. Forces also announced the results on tests conducted on suspected cases. Forces also announced the measures being taken in municipalities for preventing the spread of the virus. Forces also followed up on the entry of 89 people through the land borders.
- The General Directorate of Civil Defense prepared 427 personnel and 69 ambulances, to interfere, when necessary, and transport those infected with the emerging coronavirus. The directorate also carried out sterilization missions in public and private areas and in labs conducting PCR tests.
- ISF aided the municipalities of Qarnayel (Baabda), Qalamoun (Tripoli), and Karak (Zahle) in isolating the villages. ISF also number of fine

### Ministry of Foreign Affairs

- The Ministry communicates on a daily basis with foreign embassies that wish to evacuate their citizens in coordination with the National COVID Committee.
- The Ministry is following up on the entry and exit of diplomats visiting Lebanon on official missions, in coordination with the relevant embassies.

- The Ministry is coordinating with the Syrian embassy in Lebanon and with the General Directorate of General Security the movement of entry and exit through the border crossings to ensure the implementation of the procedures followed based on the decisions of the Council of Ministers.
- The Ministry is coordinating on a daily basis with the Lebanese missions on the development of the situation in their host countries and the situation of expatriates

## Ministry of Interior and Municipalities

- issued circular no 76/2020 on 27/7/2020 regarding the amendment of the covid 19 precautionary measures based on decision no 137/2020 that was issued on 27/7/2020
- The ministry issued Memorandum No. 74 / AM / 2020 on 23/7/2020 regarding the procedures and measures required to face this stage of the virus spread, whereby all citizens are asked to resume full compliance with public safety measures. those who fail to adhere to these measures will face consequences of Article 604 of The Penal Code. in addition owners of all public and private institutions should adhere to the maximum public safety measures

## Ministry of Public Works and Transport

- The General Directorate of Civil Aviation at the Ministry of Public Works and Transport issued Circular no. 45/2 on 28/7/2020 to all airplane companies and all arrivals to through the airport regarding new regulations in regards to PCR tests.

## General Decisions

- extended the general mobilization decision according to circular 6665/2020 from 3/8/2020 to 30/8/2020
- The council of ministers issued the decision no. 137/2020

on 27/7/2020 on the precautionary measures to control the spread of the virus, which included:

- the sectors that will be closed from 28/7/2020 and 10/8/2020. the restaurant and cafes capacity was set at 50%.
- the precautionary measures that will be taken on sea and land borders and in the airport
- closing the whole country from 30/7/2020 till 3/8/2020 and from 6/8/2020 till 10/8/2020.

- The Ministry of Youth and Sports announced the closure of all sports centers throughout from 7/30/2020 to 3/8/2020 and from 6/8/2020 to 10/8/2020, based on the circular issued by the Ministry of Interior and Municipal No. 76 / 2020
- On 7/27/2020, the Ministry of Tourism issued a statement stating that bakeries, restaurant, and can open Al Adha holiday from 6:00 AM until 8:00 PM. take aways are only allowed.

## Examples of lack of adherence to safety measures

- Demonstration, and Roadblocks
- Overcrowding in restaurants and cafes and failure to comply with the permitted number of customers (50%)
- Gathering of citizens in hiking areas without committing to preventive measures
- Non-compliance of citizens with preventive measures
- Gathering in cafes
- hookah
- gatherings on beaches and sidewalks without wearing masks.
- social gatherings and celebrations and kids areas
